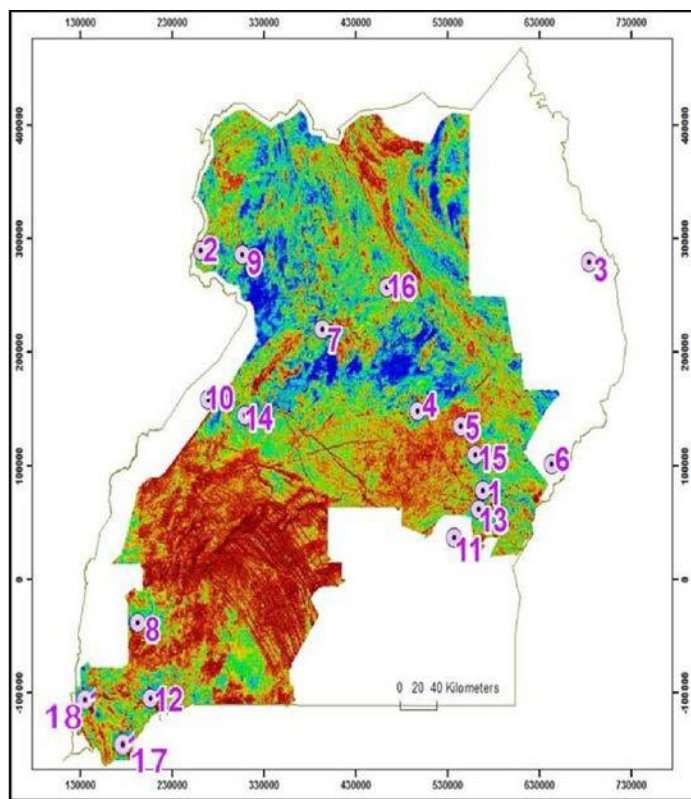


Iron Ore

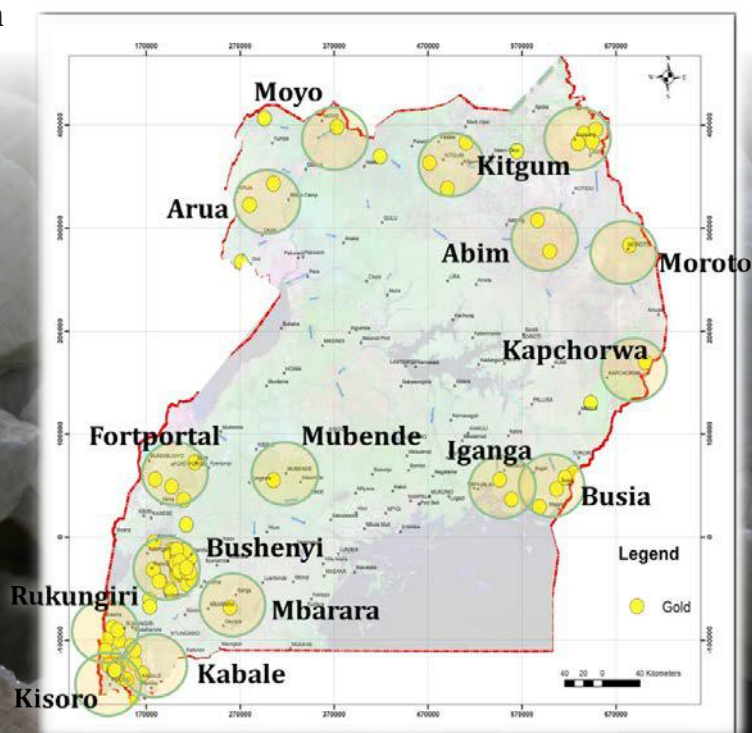

The Government of Uganda conducted an extensive acquisition, of airborne geophysical data that has attracted a number of private sector investments in the sector.

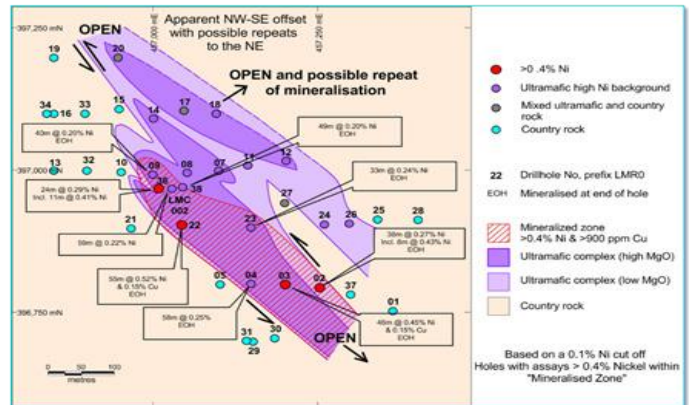

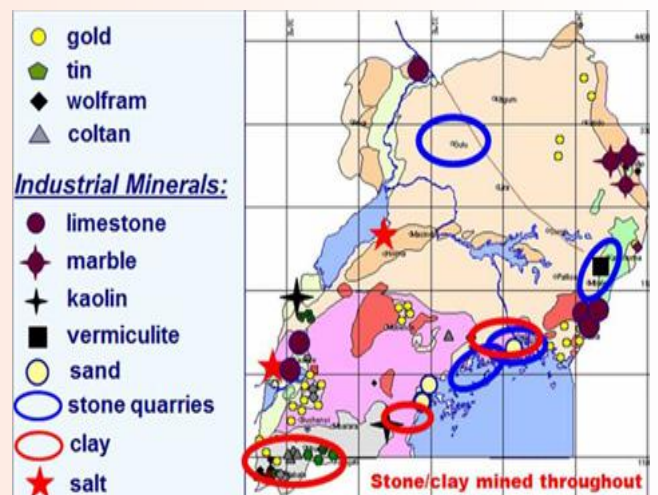

Namekara Mining Company Limited has conducted a Feasibility Study to expand plant production capacity to a minimum of 50,000 tonnes per annum from the current 30,000 tonnes per annum. In the near future Namekara shall be the leading producer of vermiculite in the world.

Government has also commenced with the registration of Artisanal and Small-scale Mining (ASM) operations across the country. There are currently over 400,000 Ugandans involved in ASM activities, 25% of who are women, who directly and indirectly benefit from mining activities.

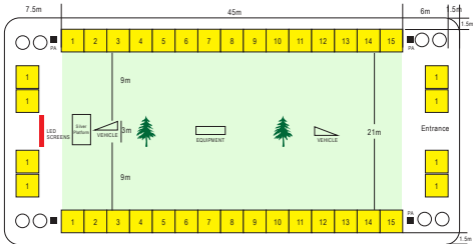
